MISTICK CONSTRUCTION TO BREAK GROUND ON NEW FACILITY FOR EAST END COOPERATIVE MINISTRY

WHAT:

A groundbreaking ceremony will be held for the new East End Cooperative Ministry (EECM) Community House. Mistick Construction Co. is the general contractor; Perkins Eastman is the architect for the project. The 64,000-square-foot facility is scheduled to be completed in late fall 2012 and is designed for a LEED Platinum Certification.

EECM is an interfaith ministry dedicated to helping at-risk children and youth, the hungry, the homeless, and others in need throughout Pittsburgh's East End. The new building will bolster the organization's offerings by consolidating program sites, providing 24-hour support services for homeless residents, and offering employment opportunities and educational programming.
